

"When you take"

Please, Show me Your glory!

Exodus 33:18



A major event in this parsha is the sin of the golden calf by the Children of Israel. Moses breaks the first set of tablets upon seeing this, and intercedes on their behalf. God proclaims His thirteen attributes of mercy to Moses. Even today, the "Thirteen Attributes of Mercy" (Exodus 34:6) are recited as part of the liturgy in the synagogue with a heart of atonement, on the High Holidays, to remember our iniquity as a people. God's mercy is beyond anything that we can ever be worthy of, and yet the price for all our sins has paid in full, by Yeshua. His love is unending.

We read in this parsha the perpetual covenant sign of the Shabbat, which is to be "a sign between me and B'nei Israel forever." (Ex. 31:17). This is also part of the liturgy that is sung in synagogues, with joy, on Shabbat.

Also crafted into this parsha we see God's choice of craftsmen, headed by Bezalel (meaning 'in the shadow of God'), who will build the Tabernacle and all the implements for ministering, to His exact specifications. They are filled with the spirit of wisdom, understanding and knowledge, Let us pray to be filled with the spirit of wisdom as we build our lives with Yeshua as our foundation. God sanctifies space and time and all aspects of our lives. Like the half shekel that is collected as the 'ransom (atonement) money', we are incomplete without our LORD. He makes us whole. Together we all are 'one' in Him. To God be the Glory forever and ever in the name of our Messiah Yeshua.. Amen!
